Stage 3	the shortlisted ideas will receive a panel visit to assess viability and the ideas developed and explored in more detail	In January 2012
Stage 4	The winner(s) will be notified	By February 10th 2012
Stage 5	the winner will receive a grant at an award ceremony	In March 2012
Stage 6	The ideas will be collated and presented as examples of best practice	from April 2012

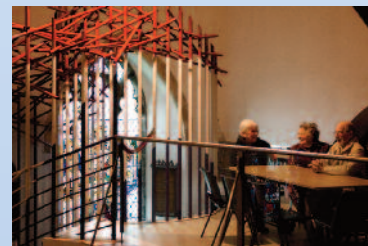

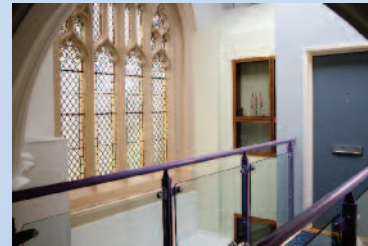
